A connection between **FOSAMAX** and other bisphosphonates, with a serious bone disease called Osteonecrosis of the Jaw (ONJ) has been found.

BISPHOSPHONATES are commonly used in tablet form to prevent and treat osteoporosis in post-menopausal women. They are also used in the treatment of **PAGET'S DISEASE**. Stronger forms given orally or intravenously (IV) are commonly used in the management of advanced cancers including, but not limited to, lung cancer, breast cancer, prostate cancer, multiple myeloma and other metastatic cancers.
